Why join Junior Rangers...?

If you like working with animals, being outdoors, trying your hand at various arts and crafts, going on walks and visiting other country parks in the Wrexham area, plus much, much more, then Junior Rangers is the group for you. Furthermore, every hour you spend at Junior Rangers will be credited towards the Wrexham 'Children's University'.

How can I join Junior Rangers...?

...Well it's easy! If you're 8 - 14, all you need to do is get your parent or guardian to fill in the application form on the back page. Junior Rangers sessions run throughout the year so there will always be a suitable group for you:

Junior Rangers is very popular and there is usually a waiting list for places, but the sooner you get your form in the sooner you will be on the list. When a space becomes available we will let you know.

Dear Parent/Guardian,

Your son/daughter has shown an interest in joining the Ty Mawr Junior Ranger group. This leaflet gives you some information about Junior Rangers and the activities they do and also has a consent form for you to fill in on the back page.

Junior Rangers are aged 8 or above and come along on a set day to learn about the park, its animals, nature, conservation, how to work with other people and how to gain a sense of responsibility for their own environment.

Once accepted as a Junior Ranger, your child will work towards a series of 4 awards starting with 'Hazel' and working towards the 'Sequoia' award.

Furthermore, Ty Mawr Country Park supports Wrexham's 'Children's University' (CU). This is a Wrexham-wide project that credits children for the time they spend on activities outside normal teaching hours. Children can work towards a bronze, silver or gold award and will receive a CU certificate and will be invited to an awards ceremony to celebrate their achievements.

Due to the nature of the work involved we must ask you to ensure that your child has an up-to-date tetanus vaccine.

We ask that parents help out with group supervision approximately once per month.
