5. If contested, the poll will take place on **Thursday 1 August 2024.**

7. Applications, amendments or cancellations of postal votes must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Guildhall, Wrexham, LL11 1AY by 5pm on Wednesday 17 July 2024.
8. Applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Guildhall, Wrexham, LL11 1AY by 5pm on Wednesday 24 July 2024.
9. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at the Guildhall, Wrexham, LL11 1AY by 5pm on Thursday 1 August 2024.

It is the responsibility of candidates to ensure that the Returning Officer receives nomination forms in the correct way, by the required deadlines.

An electronic read receipt from the Returning Officer is not confirmation that the nomination is valid. The Returning Officer will send a notice to inform candidates of his decision as to whether or not their nomination is valid. However, you should receive an automatic response from the email address shown above, which will indicate that an email has been received.
