


Hello

You are important — what you think matters. Your ideas, opinions and experiences should be listened to.

Your rights

The United Nations Convention on the Rights of the Child (UNCRC) has 54 articles on the rights of children and young people across the world. These rights are about making sure you:

- are safe
- are treated fairly
- have the things you need to survive and develop
- have a say in decisions that affect your life.

Aim 1:

We want to respect children's rights and make sure everyone knows about them.



make sure children and young people:

- have all the support they need to understand and enjoy their rights
- can take part when they want to, and nothing stops them
- are not held back because of their age, culture, belief, or any other reason
- have information that is easy to understand.


We will also make sure adults working across services know about and respect your rights!

We want to respect all children and young people, no matter who they are.



make sure children and young people:

- have opportunities to take part
- know they have the right to be involved
- can take part in Welsh or other languages they choose
- have clear information that is easy to understand and easy to find
- aren't stopped from taking part for any reason
- have support from well-trained staff.



Aim 3:

We want to listen, understand and act on children and young people's views.



make sure children and young people:

- are listened to and valued
- can give their opinion and are taken seriously
- have all the information they need to make decisions
- are involved in planning services
- are involved in checking services are working well
- are safe and can say what they think without bullying or harm.







Aim 4:

We want all children and young people to have positive goals and aspirations for their lives.



make sure children and young people:

- are encouraged to set goals for themselves
- have support from staff that believe in them and want them to achieve
- can develop their skills
- have experiences and opportunities to do things that build their confidence
- have fun and enjoy taking part.

- are thanked for taking part.



We will make sure everyone working with children and young people knows about the Participation Standards and follows them.
