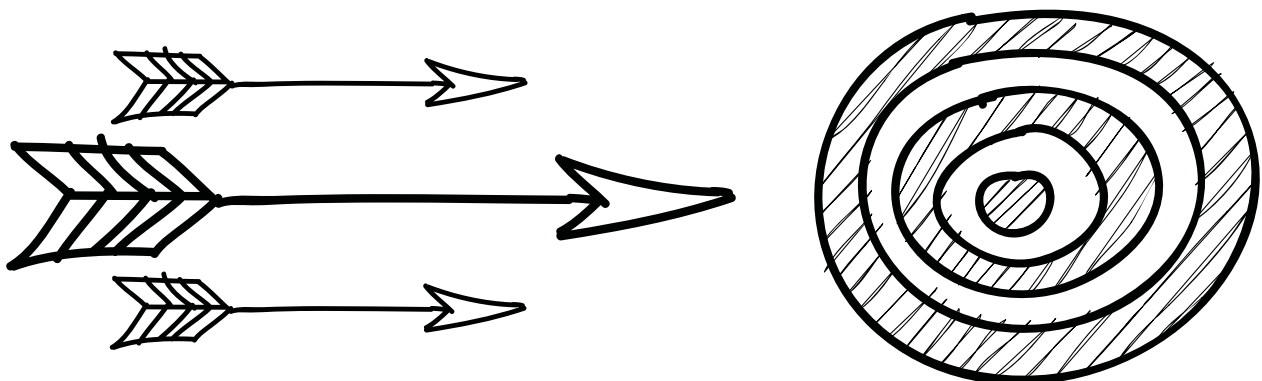


## Who are we?

The size of the schools right now is a nice size, in the future it looks like there will be more spaces.



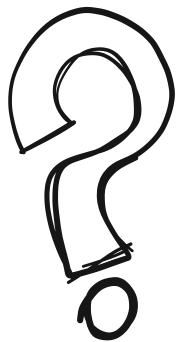
## What could change?

People telling us what they think:

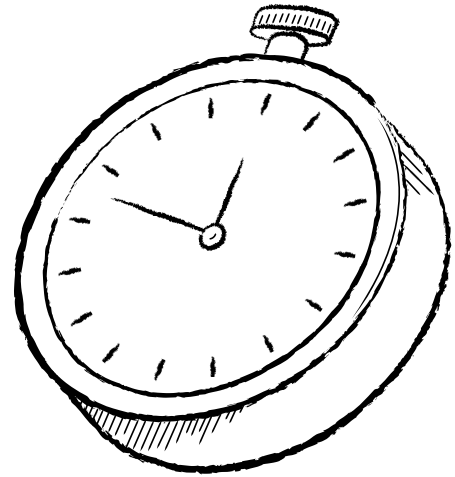
**December 2024 to January 2025**
