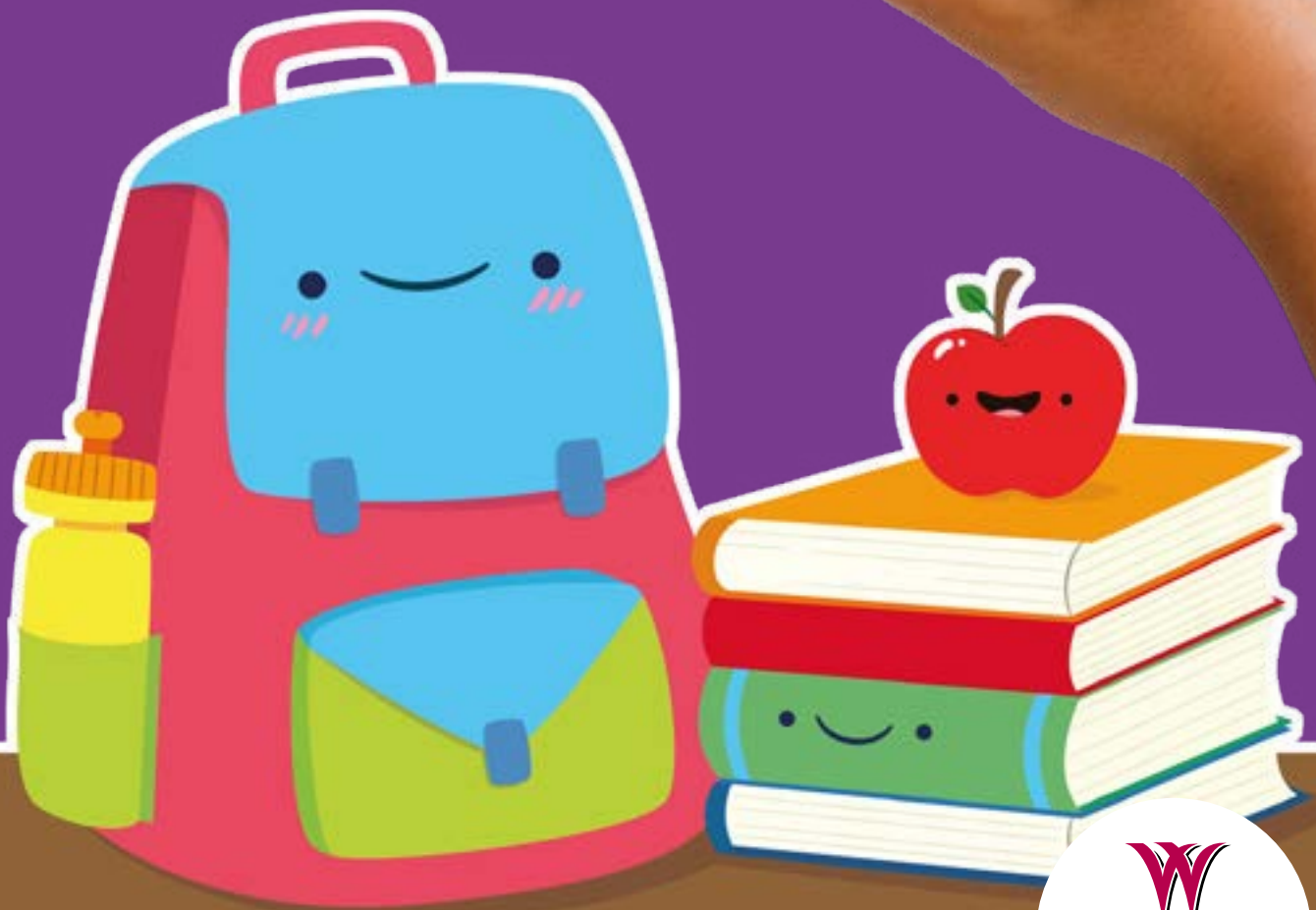

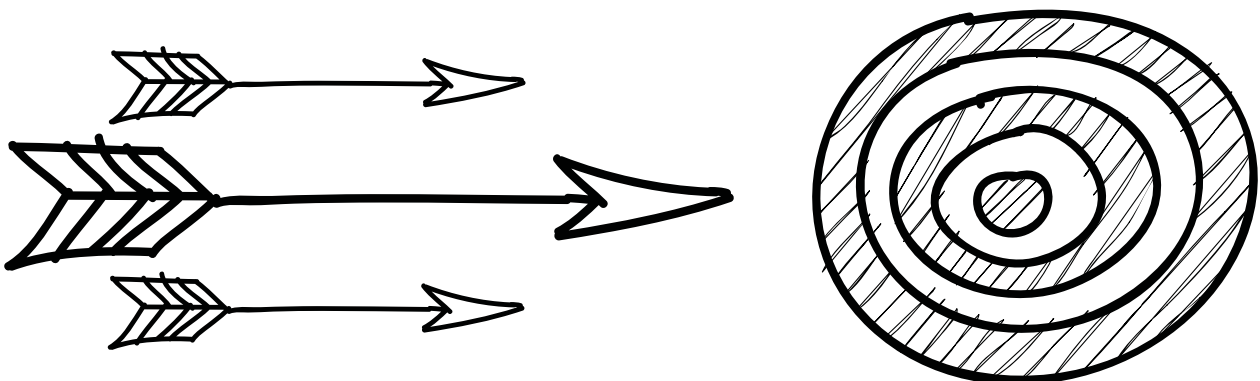

Who are we?

Wrexham County Borough Council is responsible for all schools within our area. We are part of a team that works for the Council to support these schools.

Our aims:

- To give all children the best chance to learn in excellent English speaking, Welsh speaking or Faith schools.
- To have safe and strong buildings.
- To make sure money for children is spent in a fair way.
- To give everybody the opportunity to have their voice heard and listened to in decisions that affect them.



What is happening at the moment?

At the moment Ysgol Cae'r Gwenyn is a nursery only mainstream school.

There are pupils who are older than Nursery who attend this school.

What is our idea?

To change the school so that children up to the age of 7 can go to this school.

The school is currently for children who need some extra help with their learning, this would not change.

The age range of the school will be 3-7 years.



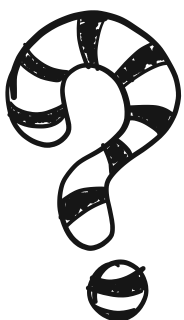
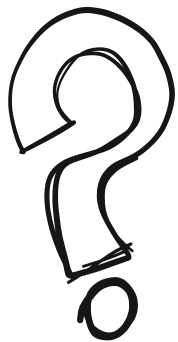
What could change?

People telling us what they think:

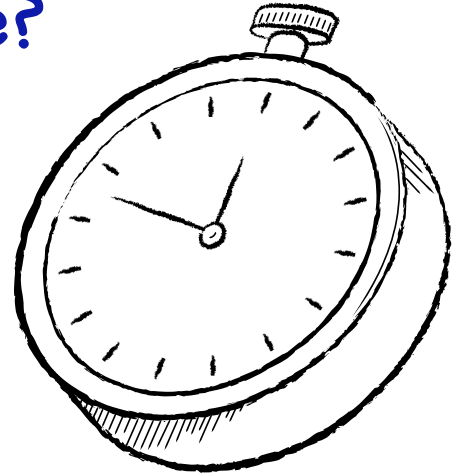
December 2024 to January 2025
